Hold on to God's report and the promises of scripture, pray those scriptures over your pregnancy, confess them daily and you will see God move every mountain and bring His word to pass.

Bible Passages

All Scripture quotations are from the KJV.

Read Psalm 139:1-24

They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the Lord, and their offspring with them. [Isaiah 65:23]

Before she travailed, she brought forth; before her pain came, she was delivered of a man child. [Isaiah 66:7]

Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations. [Jeremiah 1:5]

Weekly Prayer Guide

Week 1

Thank God for this pregnancy journey, for the privilege to carry this child. [Psalm 34:1]

Week 2

Thank God for your husband for God making you both fruitful. [Genesis 1:28]

Week 3

Thank God for putting together the intricate parts of this child. [Psalm 139]

Week 4

Invite God to go with you on this journey and that He will go ahead of you. [Exodus 33:14]

Week 5

Ask that God's power will fill your innermost parts.
[Luke 1:35]

Week 6

Ask that God will surround you as you carry this child. [Psalm 125:2, Zechariah 2:5]

Week 7

Pray for God's Spirit to rest upon you and the child. [Isaiah 11:2]

Week 8

Glorify God for every detail and plan He is fashioning about this child.
[Jeremiah 1:5]

Week 9

Ask that God will reveal the purpose of this child. [Hosea 4:6]

Week 10

Pray that this child will be a sign and wonder in this world for God's glory. [Isaiah 8:18]

Week 11

Pray for God's grace to train and nurture this child according to God's plan and purpose. [Proverbs 22:6]

Week 12

Pray for God's wisdom as you carry this pregnancy.
[Luke 2:19]

Week 13

Pray for ease during delivery like the Hebrew women. [Exodus 1:19]

Week 14

Pray that God's Shekinah glory will radiate upon you. Ask for God to show you and the child His way. [Haggai 2:7]

Week 15

Decree that this child will know God and live for God. [Joshua 24:15]

Week 16

Speak God's favor upon this child. [Luke 2:52]

Week 17

Pray that this child's destiny is forever secured in Christ. [2Timothy 1:12]

Week 18

Ask for divine strength as you carry this child.
[Philippians 4:13]

Week 19

This child is fearfully and wonderfully made.
[Psalm 139:14]

Week 20

This child is made in the image and likeness of God. [Genesis 1:27]

Week 21

This child is God's treasure. [Psalm 127:3]

Week 22

Every part of this child's body is effective and functions well. [James 1:17]

Week 23

This child will not be rebellious but will listen to wise counsel.

[Proverbs 6:20-23]

Week 24

Thank God for a perfect pregnancy journey. [Philippians 1:6]

Week 25

I cover myself with the blood of Jesus. [Exodus 12:13]

Week 26

I am anointed for a smooth and seamless pregnancy journey. [Isaiah 61:1]

Week 27

Ask that God will heal every pain and silence any complications that may want to arise during this pregnancy. [Isaiah 53:5]

Week 28

Ask that God will heal every pain and silence any complications that may want to arise during my delivery. [Isaiah 53:5]

Week 29

Ask that God will heal every pain and silence any complications that may want to arise after my delivery. [Isaiah 53:5]

Week 30

Thank God for the divine supply of all that is needed for this child to be brought forth and sustained.

[Philippians 4:19]

Week 31

Let the coming of this child usher in great testimonies and joy around me in Jesus' name. [Luke 1:14]

Week 32

I receive divine direction for this child's name. [Luke 1:26-35]

Week 33

This child is perfect, there shall be no health challenges in Jesus' name. [James 1:17]

Week 34

Ask that the blood of Jesus wipe off any negative doctor's report. [Isaiah 53:1]

Week 35

Pray that any evil report is turned around for good. [Genesis 15:20]

Week 36

This child is hidden in Christ. [Hebrews 11:23]

Week 37

God sanctify the day of my delivery.
[Numbers 6:24-26]

Week 38

Let all things work together for good for my delivery. Everyone that will take delivery of this child be used for God's purpose.

[Romans 8:28]

Week 39

I rejoice and I am glad in the Lord. Philippians 4:4

Week 40

I will carry this child with joy and this child will fulfill the number of his days. [Isaiah 12:3]
